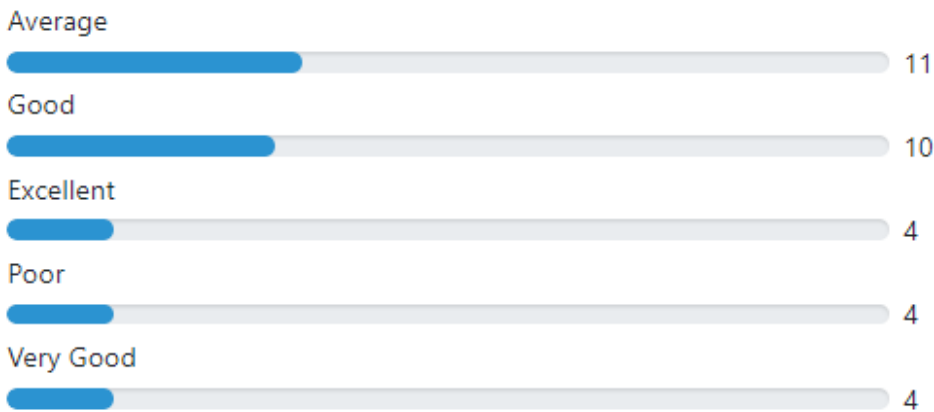
How would you rank State Representative Alex Andrade's performance as a state legislator?

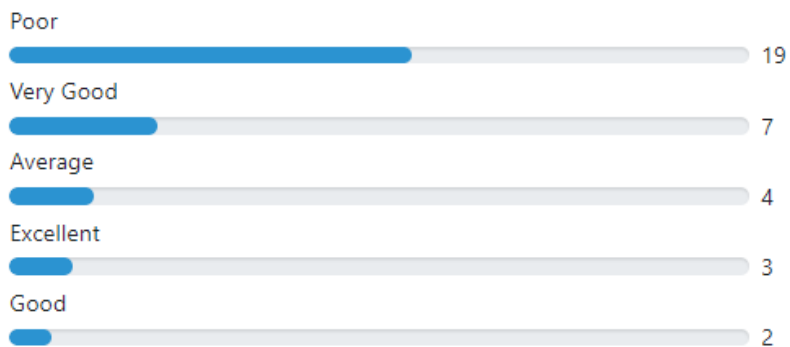

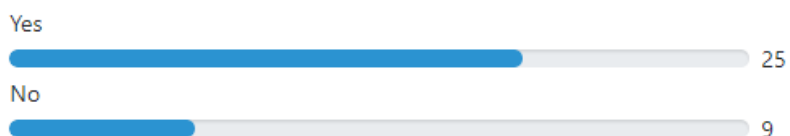

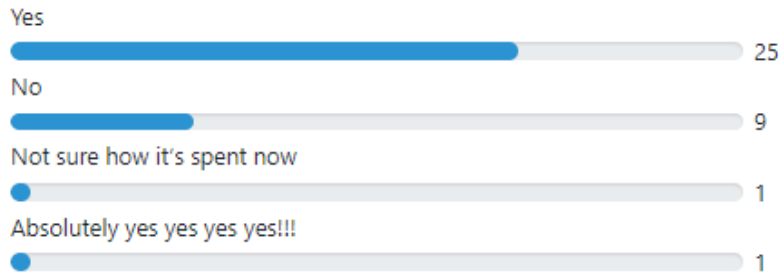
